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## 1 TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

In order to use the Capacity Market Participant Portal (PURM) it is necessary to have a computer with Internet access. PURM supports the following internet browsers:

- Microsoft Edge,
- Mozilla Firefox,
- Google Chrome,

PURM requires the installation of Java Runtime Environment software, which is available at <https://www.oracle.com/java/>.

The installation manual can be found at <https://docs.oracle.com/en/java/javase/23/install/overview-jdkinstallation.html>.

Access to PURM, allowing for participation in capacity market processes, requires setting up a user account. In order to set up an account, it is necessary to have a certificate and device allowing to sign documents with qualified electronic signature together with software provided by the signature provider.

Additionally, for Mozilla Firefox and Google Chrome, a dedicated "Szafir SDK Web" extension and the "Szafir Host" application provided by the Krajowa Izba Rozliczeniowa are required. The required software is available at the following addresses:

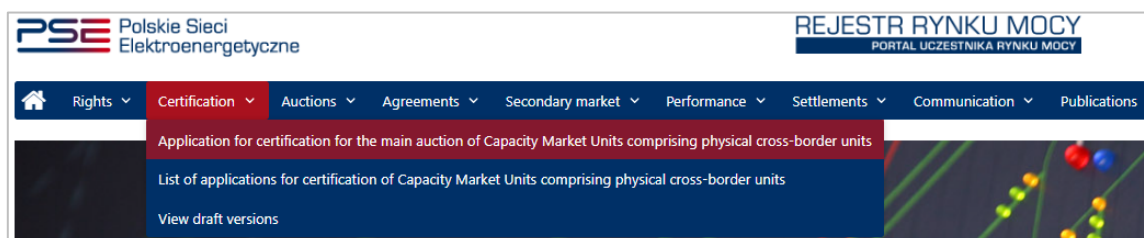

**NOTE: Notwithstanding of supporting other Internet browsers, it is recommended to use Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox.**

## 2 APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATION – GENERAL INFORMATION

To submit an application in the main certification, user shall select " **Certification**" → "**Application for certification for the main auction of Capacity Market Unit comprising physical cross-border units**".



Next, user shall confirm that the current terms of Capacity Market Rules have been read, understood and accepted by selecting "**I have read, understood and accepted current version of the Capacity Market Rules**" checkbox and clicking "**Proceed to the application**". Please note that Capacity Market Rules are executed in Polish language version only. The translation is made for working purposes exclusively and should not be treated as binding or official.

**NOTE!**

**NOTE: Filling all mandatory fields, which are marked with an asterisk " \* ", is required. In case of skipping any of these fields, proceeding to the next section is unavailable.**

User can find icons in selected areas of the application form. After positioning the cursor on the icon, hints for that section will be displayed.

If the information submitted in the application form is confidential, user is able to mark them as confidential by selecting the option "**The information in this section is confidential**".

### 2.1 Section I – The aim of the application

First section of the application form concerns the aim of the application.

First, from drop-down list marked as **"Accepted pre-auction bid identification number"**, user shall select the pre-auction bid for which the application for certification will be submitted. Each of them has its own identification number.

The drop-down list displays only bids which have been accepted or partially accepted during the pre-auction process, submitted by the capacity provider for which user is assigned with bidder or rightholder role.

In section marked as **"Subject matter of the application"**, the option **"Establishment of the Capacity Market Unit for the first time"** is automatically selected. User can also mark the option **"Establishment of a Capacity Market Unit based on a previously submitted application"**. When this option is selected, the list of applications that have been approved in previous certifications for the main auction and the user has the appropriate rights to browse them will be activated. In this case, user shall select the application number from the list.

After filling all mandatory fields or selecting the application number from the list, user shall proceed to next section by clicking **"Continue"**.

## 2.2 Section II – Capacity provider’s identification data

In this section, user shall fill capacity provider’s identification data on behalf of whom application for certification is being submitted. The identification data in this section will be automatically entered into relevant fields, based on the data included in the pre-auction bid selected in **section I**.

Subsequently, user shall proceed to another section by clicking "Continue".

## 2.3 Section III – Powers of attorney and formal documents

In section III - "Powers of attorney and formal documents", user shall provide documents necessary to be identified as person eligible to submit the application for certification. First, appropriate form of representation shall be chosen by selecting relevant radio button on the left side of the section.

On the right side of the form there are fields to attach relevant documents to the application.

**NOTE: All appendixes submitted to PURM shall be in .PDF format and shall be affixed with a qualified electronic signature of the person who submits the application. An exception is a power of attorney signed with a qualified electronic signature of representatives of the entity issuing it. The size limit for a single appendix is 20 MB.**

The required attachments shall be variable, depending on the selected form of representation.

**NOTE: Authorisation to submit applications for certification and act in the role of capacity provider (appendix 4.2 to Capacity Market Rules) shall be attached in Section Vb, at a subsequent step of filling in the application.**

- **"Single-person legal representative of the capacity provider in the relevant registry"**: in field marked as **"Document confirming the representation arrangements"** user shall attach:
  - a current extract from a relevant registry regarding capacity provider, confirming the authorization of the person submitting the application for certification.

It is not required to add appendixes in the other fields.
- **"Legal representative of the capacity provider"**: in field marked as **"Document confirming the representation arrangements"** user shall attach:
  - a current extract from a relevant registry regarding capacity provider, confirming the authority of the person signing the power of attorney.

If user has not demonstrated his power of attorney in the previous capacity market processes, in field marked as **"Document confirming the authorisation to represent the capacity provider"** user shall attach:


- appendix 4.3 do Capacity Market Rules **"Power of attorney for the register user"** authorising user to submit an application for certification on behalf of the capacity provider.


If user has demonstrated his power of attorney in the previous capacity market processes, attachment of one is not required.

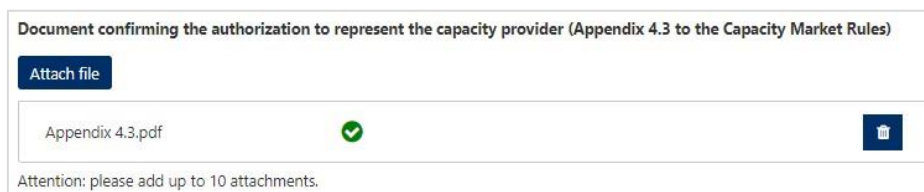
- **"Capacity provider being a natural person"** – appendixes are not required.

**NOTE: In the "Additional attachments" field, user may include other appendixes confirming the representation arrangements, helpful in evaluating the application for certification.**

It is possible to mark added appendixes as confidential.

An erroneously added appendix can be deleted with the  button. When all required appendixes have been added, clicking **"Continue"** will start the process of uploading them.

If the appendix is affixed with qualified electronic signature properly and if the process of uploading it succeeded, the appendix will be marked with „”.



In case the appendix is not affixed with a qualified electronic signature, an error **"Signature verification error"** will be displayed.



It is forbidden to add appendixes in different than .PDF format. In case of uploading a file in other format, an error **"Invalid file format, allowed file formats: PDF"** will be displayed.



After correctly adding the appendixes, user shall proceed to next section by clicking **"Continue"**.

**NOTE: Each attachment is scanned for viruses and malware. Due to the scanning process, a preview of the submitted application and appendixes may be delayed.**

### 3 APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATION – CONTENT OF THE APPLICATION

In the main certification process, the capacity market unit comprising physical cross-border units shall be qualified as:

- existing generating capacity market unit or
- unproven demand-side response capacity market unit or

Depending on the type of capacity market unit selected in **section IV**, the content of the application is various. For this reason, the application for certification for both types of units is described separately in the following sub-chapters.

If user selects the option “**Establishment of a Capacity Market Unit based on a previously submitted application**” **sections IV-VII** will be completed with the data from the application submitted in the previous certification for the main auction. The user can edit some of this data. **Section VIII** will not be completed due to necessity of attachment the required documents.

**NOTE: If the user changes the type of capacity market unit in Section IV, the data in subsequent sections will not be completed automatically based on the previous certification.**

#### 3.1 Existing generating capacity market unit

##### 3.1.1 Section IV - Capacity market unit establishment

The completion of **section IV** shall start with name of the capacity market unit in the indicated field:

**NOTE: Name of the capacity market unit shall be freely determined by user. It is recommended that its name refers to the content of the capacity market unit, e.g. "ABC Power Station Unit 1".**

Next, user shall select the requested duration of the capacity obligation to be offered during the capacity auction. The default duration of the capacity obligation is 1 year. Since foreign units are not allowed to be granted with longer contracts, it is not possible to modify the value of this field.

The following step is to add the individual physical cross-border units forming part of capacity market unit to be created. The user can do it in three different ways:

- by checking the box **"Choose the unit from the list of physical cross-border units previously entered into the register"** and selecting a physical cross-border unit from the list of units available to the user,

In order to add physical cross-border unit, user shall provide its data such as: "**Name of physical cross-border unit**", "**Net maximum capacity**", "**Gross maximum capacity**" and "**EIC Code**" in relevant fields. "**Type of physical cross-border unit**" is not editable.

After choosing the physical cross-border unit or filling in the data, "Add unit" button is activated. Clicking it adds the physical cross-border unit to the capacity market unit which is indicated by adding new record to the table.

The capacity market unit, in accordance with Article 16(1) of the Capacity Market Act, may comprise more than one physical cross-border unit.

After adding all physical cross-border units to the capacity market unit, in order to proceed with the application, user shall make the following statements:

- "I agree to the acquisition by the PSE of metering/billing data concerning physical cross-border units declared for an auction in a given certification, from the commencement date of the delivery period to the end of the certificate validity period."
- "I declare that no circumstances referred to in Article 16 (2) of the Capacity Market Act have occurred or will occur for any physical cross-border unit that will form part of the capacity market unit to be created."

**NOTE: Submission of both statements is required to continue submitting the application for certification.**

Moreover, certification form requires to submit declarations regarding the commercial production start date and the CO<sub>2</sub> emission limits. First, user shall choose from two possible options regarding the commercial production start date, listed below:

- **Declaration 1.A:** "I declare that all generating units included in physical cross-border units forming part of capacity market unit to be created have started commercial production before 4<sup>th</sup> of July 2019."
- **Declaration 1.B:** "I declare that at least one of generating units included in physical cross-border units forming part of capacity market unit to be created has not started commercial production yet or has started commercial production on 4<sup>th</sup> of July 2019 or later."

It is required to submit one of them by selecting relevant radio button.

**NOTE: The names and numbering of the declarations have been entered for the purpose of this manual only.**

After filling all mandatory fields, user shall proceed to another section by clicking "**Continue**".

In the meantime, system checks if the requirements mentioned in Article 16(1) of the Capacity Market Act are fulfilled. Positive verification enables user to proceed to the next section. Otherwise, a relevant message will be displayed and "**Continue**" button will be disabled until all necessary corrections are entered.

### 3.1.2 Section V – Physical cross-border unit owner identification data and formal documents

**Section V** concerns the owner identification data and formal documents of the physical cross-border units forming part of the capacity market unit.

**NOTE: If the capacity market unit comprises more than one physical cross-border unit, the owner's identification data and formal documents shall be completed for each physical cross-border unit separately. It is possible to switch between tabs related to individual physical cross-border units by selecting a relevant tab from the panel above.**

The completion of this section shall start with name of the physical cross-border unit's owner and its legal form. In case of entities based outside of the Republic of Poland, user shall select "**foreign entity**" from the drop-down list marked as "**Legal form**".

**NOTE: If the desired legal form is not on the list, user shall select "other" and indicate that form in the field marked as "Additional Information".**

Selected legal form determines the data to be provided in field marked as **"Identification data"**.

Depending on the requirements, user shall provide: NIP, REGON, KRS or PESEL of the physical cross-border unit owner. If the owner does not have an assigned PESEL number, select the **"Person does not have a PESEL number"**, which allows user to enter a passport number instead.

**NOTE: In the case of a sole proprietor, select "sole proprietor" in the "Legal form", and further complete the NIP and REGON number. In this case, the PESEL number is not required.**

If, under the regulations of the capacity market, more than one NIP, REGON or PESEL number is required (e.g., if it is necessary to provide data of all partners of a civil partnership), they should be entered in the **"Additional information"**.

In the next step, user shall enter contact details: **"Telephone number"** and **"E-mail address"**. The data are not required but may be useful in communication purposes.

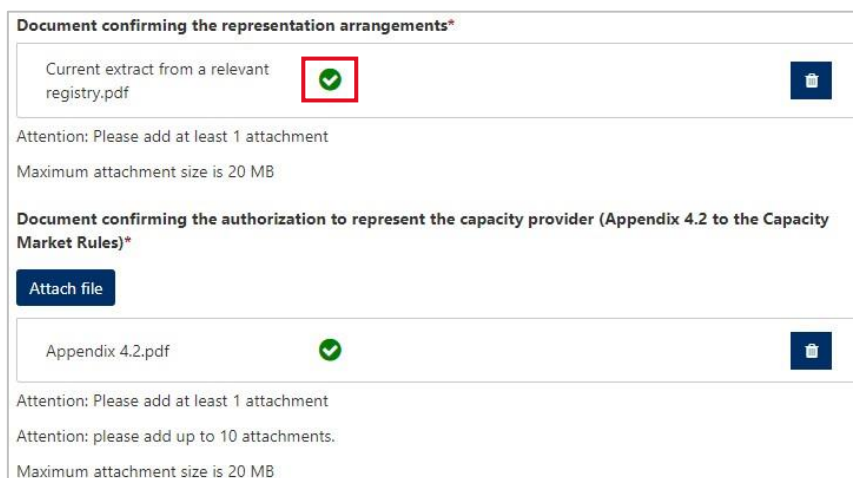

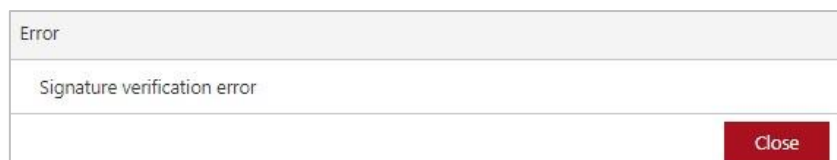


When all required appendixes have been added, clicking **"Next section"** will start the uploading process.

If the appendix is affixed with qualified electronic signature properly and the process of uploading it succeeded, the appendix is marked with „✓”.



In case the appendix is not affixed with a qualified electronic signature, an error **"Signature verification error"** will be displayed.



If the attachment has not been properly signed with a qualified electronic signature and the upload process has failed, the attachment will be marked with “❗”.

It is forbidden to add appendixes in different than .PDF format. In case of uploading a file in other format, an error "Invalid file format, allowed file formats: PDF" will be displayed.

After the appendixes has been added correctly, user shall proceed to next section by clicking "Next section".

**NOTE: Each attachment is scanned for viruses and malware. Due to the scanning process, a preview of the submitted application and appendixes may be delayed.**

### 3.1.2.3. Section Vc – Location and technical parameters of physical cross-border unit

**Section Vc** concerns the location and technical parameters of physical cross-border unit forming part of the capacity market unit which is the subject of the application for certification.

**NOTE: In case of addition of a physical cross-border unit in Section IV using the option "Choose the unit from the list of physical cross-border units previously entered into the register", fields in this section will automatically be completed with the data from the register.**

On the left side of the form, user shall enter the location of the physical cross-border unit. The mandatory fields are:

- "Country",
- "Place",
- "Postcode"
- „House number”.

**NOTE: House number means the number of the building or property.**

If a physical cross-border unit has not been assigned with a house number, the value "0" shall be entered in the **"House number"** field. Instead, the registration numbers of all the parcels with their respective precincts shall be entered in the **"Additional information"** field. In addition, it is possible to mark the information submitted in this section as confidential.

**NOTE: It is also possible to attach a list of the parcels on which the physical cross-border unit is located in the field "Additional information" in Section Vb.**

On the right side of the form, user can find section regarding the technical parameters of physical cross-border unit.

**NOTE: The change of the net and gross maximum capacity of a physical cross-border unit is possible in Section IV.**

The mandatory fields are:

- **"Function in the system"** – chosen in accordance with the list in section 6.2.2.2 of the Capacity Market Rules.

- **"Technology of energy production"** - chosen in accordance with the list in section 6.2.2.3 of the Capacity Market Rules.

**NOTE: If the given physical cross-border unit uses an energy production technology not included in the defined list, the option "other" shall be selected and information about the used energy production technology shall be entered in the field "Additional information".**

- **"Basic energy source"** - chosen in accordance with the list in section 6.2.2.4 of the Capacity Market Rules

### 3.1.3. Section VI – Technical parameters

In this section, user shall indicate unit CO<sub>2</sub> emission factor (g/KWh) regarding capacity market unit as a whole. Value shall be filled into the table below.

**NOTE: A detailed description in regard to determination the values of technical parameters is presented in the document entitled "Metodyka obliczeń wartości parametrów techniczno-ekonomicznych" available at [www.rynekmocy.pl](http://www.rynekmocy.pl) in the section "Certyfikacja do aukcji".**

According to section 5.2.3.7 of the Capacity Market Rules, capacity market unit's CO<sub>2</sub> unit emission factor shall not exceed value indicated in the pre-auction offer, which is displayed above the table.

If unit emission factor has been added, user shall make the following statement:

- "I declare that established capacity market unit does not consist of physical cross-border units with a carbon dioxide emission factor higher than value stated in the pre-auction bid being the subject of the application."

If any of the fields is omitted, the message "**Field is required**" will be displayed and the "Continue" button will be disabled.

**NOTE:** If the capacity market unit does not emit a particular type of substance, emission factor shall be filled as "0". User may mark all added parameters as confidential by selecting the checkbox:

After filling all mandatory fields user can proceed to the next section by clicking the "**Continue**" button.

### 3.1.4. Section VIII – Attachments

In **section VIII** user shall add appendixes relating to the individual physical cross-border units forming part of the capacity market unit, appendixes regarding the capacity market unit itself and appendixes regarding the capacity provider. By default, after entering **section VIII**, the tab concerning the first added physical cross-border unit opens.

If the physical unit does not have such restrictions, user shall enter "None" in this field. Completion of this field is mandatory - a maximum of 1000 characters may be entered.
- **Commitment issued by the relevant transmission system operator within whose territory the physical cross-border unit is located, to provide the PSE with metering/billing data and data regarding generation bids submitted by a physical cross-border unit (Appendix 7.5 to the Capacity Market Rules)** – user shall add the Appendix 7.5 to the Capacity Market Rules, issued by the relevant transmission system operator within whose territory the foreign physical cross-border unit is located. Adding at least one appendix in this field is mandatory. A maximum of 10 appendixes can be added.

In section "**Appendixes regarding the Capacity Market Unit**" following appendixes shall be attached:

- **Data necessary to verify the calculation of unit CO<sub>2</sub> emission in regard to generating units (Appendix 7.10 to the Capacity Market Rules)** – user shall add the Appendix 7.10 to the

Capacity Market Rules. Adding the appendix in this field is mandatory, only for units that include generating units for which at least one of the sources of basic energy is a source referred to in Section. 6.2.2.4 subsections 10), 16) - 37), 29) - 34 and 40) Capacity Market Rules.

- any additional appendixes regarding the capacity market unit.

Last section "**Appendixes regarding the capacity provider**" following appendixes shall be attached:

- **Information provided when applying for state aid other than agricultural or fishing aid, de minimis aid or de minimis aid in agriculture and fishing** - user shall add the form of information, drawn up in accordance with the template forming Attachment 1 to the Regulation of the Council of Ministers of 29 March 2010 (Journal of Laws of 2010, No. 53, item 312) in respect to the scope of provided information by the entity applying for state aid other than agriculture or fishing aid, de minimis aid or de minimis aid in agriculture or fishing. Adding the appendix in this field is mandatory,
- **Statement on the economic situation of the entity as a group** - user shall add a statement in accordance with the template available at: <https://www.pse.pl/web/pse-eng/areas-of-activity/capacity-market/certification-for-auction>. Adding the appendix in this field is mandatory,
- **Financial statements for the last 3 financial years** - financial statements for the past 3 financial years, drawn up in accordance with the relevant laws of the capacity provider's country of domicile or residence. Adding the appendix in this field is mandatory.

**NOTE: A detailed description of way of completing the appendixes on state aid is presented in the materials posted on [www.rynekmocy.pl](http://www.rynekmocy.pl) in the section "Certyfikacja do aukcji", in the document called "Badanie sytuacji ekonomicznej przedsiębiorstwa w kontekście udziału w rynku mocy" and in the section "[Certification for auction](#)" under the appropriate tabs.**

Each of the appendixes may be marked as confidential by selecting relevant checkbox.

**NOTE: All appendixes submitted to PURM shall be in .PDF format and shall be affixed with a qualified electronic signature of the person who submits the application. ### 3.1.5. Section IX – Volume of capacity obligation

**Section IX** regards the capacity obligation to be offered during the capacity auction by the capacity market unit.

The values displayed in **section IX** are calculated based on the data entered by user in **sections IV and V**. The section shall contain the following data:

- **Net maximum capacity of the Capacity Market Unit (MW)** – calculated as the sum of net maximum capacities of each physical cross-border unit forming part of the capacity market unit;
- **De-rating factor of the Capacity Market Unit** – in case of capacity market unit comprising multiple physical cross-border units it is determined as the lowest value of de-rating factors assigned to each physical cross-border unit;
- **Volume of capacity obligation accepted in the pre-auction (MW)** – maximum capacity obligation to be offered in the capacity auction taking into account only the capacity obligation accepted during the pre-auction;
- **Maximum volume of capacity obligation that can be offered in auction (MW)** – maximum capacity obligation to be offered in the capacity auction taking into account only net maximum capacity of the capacity market unit and its de-rating factor
- **Volume of capacity obligation to be offered in the auction (MW)** – volume of capacity obligation which will be offered during the capacity auction.

**NOTE: In field "Volume of capacity obligation to be offered in the auction (MW)" user may enter a volume of capacity obligation higher or equal to 2 MW and no higher than the maximum capacity obligation to be offered and the capacity obligation accepted during the pre-auction. If the entered value does not meet these conditions, the note is displayed and the possibility to proceed to the next section on is blocked.**

It is possible to mark the value of offered capacity obligation as confidential by selecting checkbox:

After filling all mandatory fields user can proceed to the next section by clicking the "**Continue**" button. Further steps, including the process of signing the application, are described in Section 3.3

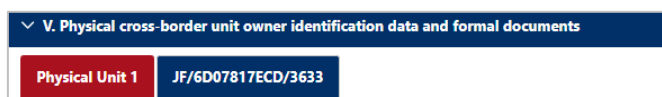

**NOTE: All appendixes submitted to PURM shall be in .PDF format and shall be affixed with a qualified electronic signature of the person who submits the application. An exception is a power of attorney signed with a qualified electronic signature of representatives of the entity issuing it. The size limit for a single appendix is 20 MB.**

In field marked as "**Document confirming the representation arrangements**" user shall attach:

- a current extract from a relevant registry regarding physical cross-border unit's owner, confirming the authority of the person signing the power of attorney.

In field marked as **"Document confirming the authorisation to represent the capacity provider (Appendix 4.2 to the Capacity Market Rules)"** user shall attach:


- appendix 4.2 do Capacity Market Rules **"Authorisation to submit applications for certification and act in the role of capacity provider"** authorising user to use given physical cross-border unit in capacity market unit to be created.

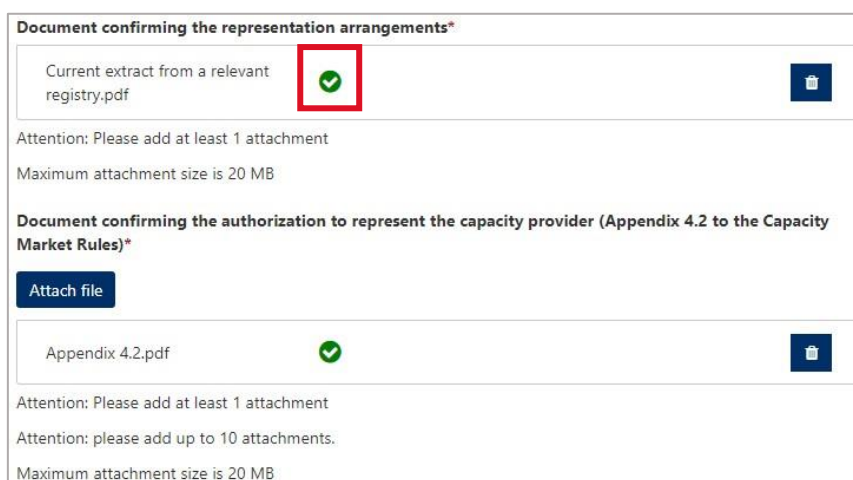

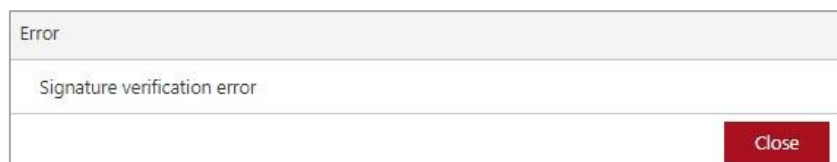



When all required appendixes have been added, clicking **"Next section"** will start the process of uploading them.

If the appendix is affixed with qualified electronic signature properly and if the process of uploading it succeeded, the appendix will be marked with „”.



In case the appendix is not affixed with a qualified electronic signature, an error **"Signature verification error"** will be displayed.



If the attachment has not been properly signed with a qualified electronic signature and the upload process has failed, the attachment will be marked with “”.

It is forbidden to add appendixes in different than .PDF format. In case of uploading a file in other format, an error "Invalid file format, allowed file formats: PDF" will be displayed.



After correctly adding the appendixes, user shall proceed to next section by clicking "Next section".

**NOTE: Each attachment is scanned for viruses and malware. Due to the scanning process, a preview of the submitted application and appendixes may be delayed.**

### 3.2.2.3. Section Vc – Location and technical parameters of physical cross-border unit

**Section Vc** concerns the location and technical parameters of physical cross-border unit forming part of the capacity market unit which is the subject of the application for certification. This section will be described separately for the physical cross-border demand side response unit without internal energy source and physical cross-border demand side response unit with internal energy source.

**NOTE: In case of addition of a physical cross-border unit in section IV using the option "Choose the unit from the list of physical cross-border units previously entered into the register", the fields in this section will automatically be completed with the data from the register.**

#### a. Physical cross-border demand-side response unit without internal energy source

On the left-hand side of the form, user shall enter the location of the physical cross-border unit. The mandatory fields are:

- "Country",
- "Place",
- "Postcode",
- „House number”.

**NOTE: House number means the number of the building or property.**

Where a physical cross-border unit has not been assigned with a house number, the value "0" shall be entered in the "House number" field. Instead, the registration numbers of all the parcels with their respective precincts shall be entered in the "Additional information" field. In addition, it is possible to mark the information submitted in this section as confidential.

**NOTE: It is also possible to attach a list of the parcels on which the physical cross-border unit is located in the field "Additional information" in Section Vb.**

On the right side of the form one can find section regarding the technical parameters of physical cross-border unit.

**NOTE: The change of the net maximum capacity of a physical cross-border unit is possible in Section IV.**

If the physical cross-border unit includes energy storage, user shall also provide its parameters in section **"Storage parameters"**.

All abovementioned information may be marked as confidential.

After filling all mandatory fields, user shall proceed to another section by clicking **"Continue"**.

#### b. Physical cross-border demand side response unit with internal energy source

On the left-hand side of the form, user shall enter the location of the physical cross-border unit. The mandatory fields are:

### 3.2.3 Section VI – Technical parameters

**Section VI** is displayed and mandatory if at least one physical cross-border demand side response unit with internal energy source will form part of the capacity market unit to be created.

In the case of unproven demand side response capacity market units without internal energy source, section VI (technical parameters) is inactive, and the system automatically directs us to the next section, "Attachments".

In this section, user shall indicate unit CO<sub>2</sub> emission factor (g/KWh) regarding capacity market unit as a whole. Value shall be filled into the table below.

**NOTE: A detailed description of how to determine the values of technical parameters is presented in the document entitled "Metodyka obliczeń wartości parametrów techniczno-ekonomicznych" available at [www.rynekmocy.pl](http://www.rynekmocy.pl) in the section „Certyfikacja do aukcji”.**

According to section 5.2.3.7 of the Capacity Market Rules, capacity market unit's CO<sub>2</sub> unit emission factor shall not exceed value indicated in the pre-auction offers, which is displayed in this section.

If unit emission factor has been added, user shall make the following statement:

- "I declare that established capacity market unit does not consist of physical cross-border units with a carbon dioxide emission factor higher than value stated in the pre-auction bid being the subject of the application."

If any of the fields is omitted, the message "**Field is required**" will be displayed and the "**Continue**" button will be disabled.

**Note: If the capacity market unit does not emit a particular type of substance, emission factor shall be filled as "0".**

User may mark all added parameters as confidential by selecting relevant checkbox.

After filling all mandatory fields, user shall proceed to another section by clicking "**Continue**".

### 3.2.4 Section VIII – Attachments

In **section VIII** user shall add appendixes relating to the individual physical cross-border units forming part of the capacity market unit, appendixes regarding the capacity market unit itself and appendixes regarding the capacity provider. By default, after entering **section VIII**, the tab concerning the first added physical cross-border unit opens.

It is possible to switch between tabs regarding physical cross-border units, capacity market unit and capacity provider by selecting the appropriate tab from the panel above.

In regard to physical cross-border units, system displays fields:

- **Confirmation stating compliance with the actual situation of the technical parameters and location of physical cross-border unit (Appendix 7.4 to the Capacity Market Rules)** – user shall add the Appendix 7.4 to the Capacity Market Rules, issued by the relevant transmission system operator within whose territory the foreign physical cross-border unit is located. Adding at least one appendix in this field is mandatory. A maximum of 20 appendixes can be added.
- **Commitment issued by the relevant transmission system operator within whose territory the physical cross-border unit is located, to provide PSE with metering/billing data and data regarding generation bids submitted by a physical cross-border unit (Appendix 7.5 to the Capacity Market Rules)** – user shall add the Appendix 7.5 to the Capacity Market Rules, issued by the relevant transmission system operator within whose territory the foreign physical cross-border unit is located. Adding at least one appendix in this field is mandatory. A maximum of 10 appendixes can be added.

In section "Appendixes regarding the capacity market unit" following appendixes shall be attached:

- **Data necessary to verify the calculation of unit CO<sub>2</sub> emission factor in regard to generating units (Appendix 7.10 to the Capacity Market Rules)** – user shall add the Appendix 7.10 to the Capacity Market Rules. Adding the appendix in this field is mandatory if at least one physical cross-border demand side response unit with internal energy source will form part of the capacity market unit to be created and include generating units for which at least one of the sources of basic energy is a source referred to in Section. 6.2.2.4 subsections 10), 16) – 27), 29) - 34) and 40) Capacity Market Rules.
  - any additional appendixes regarding the capacity market unit.

Moreover, in this section user shall provide:

- **Information on the actions by which reduction of capacity demand from a Capacity Market Unit will be performed** – adding text information in this field is mandatory. Include a brief description of how the capacity reduction will be achieved, such as: turning off facilities, reducing production, etc. A maximum of 3000 characters can be added.

Last section "**Appendixes regarding the capacity provider**" following appendixes shall be attached:

- **Information provided when applying for state aid other than agricultural or fishing aid, de minimis aid or de minimis aid in agriculture and fishing** - user shall add the form of information, drawn up in accordance with the template forming Attachment 1 to the Regulation of the Council of Ministers of 29 March 2010 (Journal of Laws of 2010, No. 53, item 312) in respect to the scope of provided information by the entity applying for state aid other than agriculture or fishing aid, de minimis aid or de minimis aid in agriculture or fishing. Adding the appendix in this field is mandatory,
- **Statement on the economic situation of the entity as a group** - user shall add a statement in accordance with the template available at: <https://www.pse.pl/web/pse-eng/areas-of-activity/capacity-market/certification-for-auction> in section "**Statement on the economic situation**". Adding the appendix in this field is mandatory,
- **Financial statements for the last 3 financial years** - financial statements for the past 3 financial years, drawn up in accordance with the relevant laws of the capacity provider's country of domicile or residence. Adding the appendix in this field is mandatory.

**NOTE: A detailed description of way of completing the appendixes on state aid is presented in the materials posted on [www.rynekmocy.pl](http://www.rynekmocy.pl) in the section "Certyfikacja do aukcji", in the document called "Badanie sytuacji ekonomicznej przedsiębiorstwa w kontekście udziału w rynku mocy" and in the section "[Certification for auction](#)" under the appropriate tabs.**

Any of the appendixes may be marked as confidential by selecting relevant checkbox.

**NOTE: All appendixes submitted to PURM shall be in .PDF format and shall be affixed with a qualified electronic signature of the person who submits the application. An exception is a power of attorney signed with a qualified electronic signature of representatives of the entity issuing it. The size limit for a single appendix is 20 MB.**

Next, user should start the process of uploading attachments to the application by clicking "**Continue**". If not all of the requirements of this section have been met, e.g. user did not add all required attachments, the process of filling in the application will be stopped and user will be informed through appropriate icons in the panel for which units the appendixes are missing.



If the appropriate corrections have been made, the "**Continue**" button will be unlocked. Clicking it will add attachments to the form and proceed to the next section.

### 3.2.5 Section IX – Volume of capacity obligation

**Section IX** regards the capacity obligation to be offered during the capacity auction by the capacity market unit.

The values displayed in **section IX** are calculated based on the data entered by user in **sections IV and V**. The section shall contain the following data:

- **Net maximum capacity of the Capacity Market Unit (MW)** – calculated as the sum of net maximum capacities of each physical cross-border unit forming part of the capacity market unit;
- **De-rating factor of the Capacity Market Unit** – in case of capacity market unit comprising multiple physical cross-border units it is determined as the lowest value of de-rating factors assigned to each physical cross-border unit;
- **Volume of capacity obligation accepted in the pre-auction (MW)** – maximum capacity obligation to be offered in the capacity auction taking into account only the capacity obligation accepted during the pre-auction;
- **Maximum volume of capacity obligation that can be offered in the auction (MW)** – maximum capacity obligation to be offered in the capacity auction taking into account only net maximum capacity of the capacity market unit and its de-rating factor;
- **Volume of capacity obligation to be offered in the auction (MW)** – volume of capacity obligation which will be offered during the capacity auction.

**NOTE:** In field "Volume of capacity obligation to be offered in the auction (MW)" user may enter a volume of capacity obligation higher or equal to 2 MW and no higher than the maximum capacity obligation to be offered and the capacity obligation accepted during the pre-auction. If the entered value does not meet these conditions, a note is displayed and the possibility to proceed to the next section on is blocked.

It is possible to mark the value of offered capacity obligation as confidential by selecting relevant checkbox.

After filling all mandatory fields, user shall proceed to another section by clicking "**Continue**".

### 3.3 Reviewing, editing and signing the application

After correctly filling out all sections, the user has the option to save a draft of the application, edit the application, or sign the application.

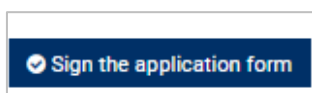

By clicking "Edit" user is able to return to previous section of the application form. Then, by clicking "Return" or "Continue", user may navigate through the sections of the application. Moreover, user is able to view each section by selecting the relevant section header (by clicking on the header), however in view mode, it is not possible to edit the data.

After the application for certification has been properly signed, user shall confirm its submission by SMS code. The SMS code shall be sent to the phone number assigned to user account. In order to confirm submission, the received SMS code shall be entered into the **"SMS code"** field and confirmed by clicking **"Confirm"** button.

**NOTE: In order to successfully submit an application for certification, it is necessary to sign it with a qualified electronic signature and enter the SMS code. Failure to complete any of these steps will result in the application not being submitted.**

## 3.4 Draft certification application

### 3.4.1 Save as draft certification application

At any time during the application for certification, it is possible to interrupt the process and save a draft version of the application for later continuation.

At the application submission stage, a **"Save as Draft"** button is available at the bottom of the application form.

**NOTE: The "Save as Draft" button is not available when correcting the application after it has been returned by the OSP.**

Clicking the **"Save as draft"** button opens a window for entering its name. The user can enter a unique name for the draft application, which will enable them to identify the saved application later. Confirming with the **"Save"** button saves a draft application.

The successful saving of the draft version is confirmed by the following message:

After saving the draft version, the user can finish working on the application and complete it at any time during the application submission period in the auction certification process.

**NOTE! Saving a draft version is not the same as submitting an application. For an application to be considered submitted, it must be completed in full, signed with a qualified electronic signature, and the correct SMS code must be entered.**

If the name of the draft being saved is identical to a name previously used by the user, the system will display an appropriate message. The user can re-enter a different, unique draft name or overwrite the existing draft under that name.

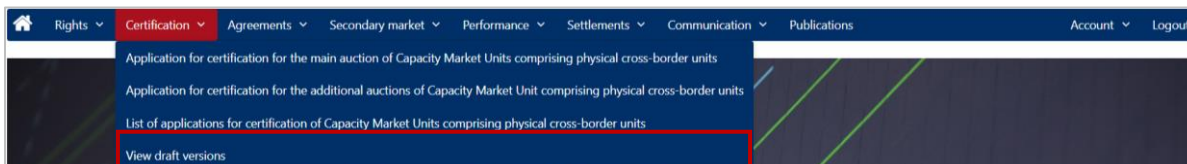
Overwriting the draft version results in saving the current status of the document under the existing name specified by the user, without the possibility of returning to the previous content of the draft copy.

### 3.4.2 Continuation of certification application based on draft version

To continue submitting a certification application saved as a draft, select **“Certification”** → **“View draft version”** from the main menu.



After selecting a menu item, a list of applications saved as the user's draft is displayed.

**NOTE! The functionality of browsing drafts is only available during the application period for certification.**

The list allows filtering by name or part of the name, the date the draft was saved, or the certification year. Once the user selects a draft, the **“Proceed with the application submission”** button is activated.

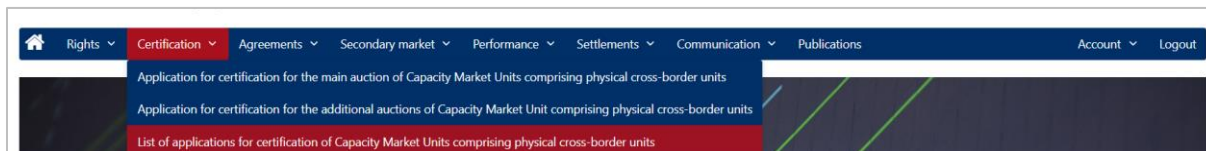

## 4 BROWSING, WITHDRAWING AND RECTIFYING THE APPLICATIONS

In order to view the submitted applications for certification, user shall select **"Certification"** → **"List of applications for certification of Capacity Market Units comprising physical cross-border units"** from the main menu.



System proceeds to the list of applications for certification submitted by user. Moreover, list also contains applications submitted by other users, in regard to capacity providers for which user is assigned with rights to view the applications. The list may be refreshed by clicking **"Refresh"**.

## 4.1. Downloading the application, appendixes to the application and certificates

### 4.1.1. Generating the certificate

After the PSE has accepted the application, user may generate the certificate issued for the capacity market unit which was the subject of the application.

In order to generate the certificate, user shall select the application by clicking on a given row of the table and click "**Download the certificate**". This button is available only in case the application for certification was approved by the PSE.

User is able to generate a certificate in regard to applications assigned with status "**Approved**" or "**Conditionally approved**".

**NOTE: Status of the application "Conditionally approved" is assigned to applications, which are accepted by the PSE and concern the unproven demand-side response capacity market units. In order to change its status to "Approved" capacity provider shall establish appropriate financial collateral.**

### 4.1.2. Downloading the application and appendixes to the application

In order to download application form or any of the appendixes, user shall select given application and click "**List of appendixes and remarks**". A table is displayed with a PDF files containing the submitted application and its appendixes. User is able to download them by clicking on the document icon on the right side of the table.
