1 TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

In order to use the Capacity Market Participant Portal (PURM) it is necessary to have a computer with Internet access. Detailed technical requirements are available at <https://www.pse.pl/web/pse-eng/areas-of-activity/capacity-market/purm-register>.


User account establishment, logging in and managing user account is described in the *Portal Uczestnika Rynku Mocy User manual. Pre-auction process*, which is available on the [website](#).

2 SUBSCRIPTION TO RECEIVE INFORMATION ABOUT SYSTEM STRESS EVENTS

2.1 Sign up for subscription

In order to sign up for subscription to receive information about announced system stress event, provided in accordance with point 16.3.2.1, subpoint 3 of the Capacity Market Rules, please visit Capacity Market Register (<https://purm.pse.pl>), and select “**Subscribe**” button.

NOTE! Users of the register, including those with the role of rightholder or bidder, as well as persons included on the list to be notified via SMS and e-mail about the announcement of a test system stress event referred to in section 3, are not automatically subscribed to notifications about the announcement of the system stress event.

NOTE! Subscribing is a publicly available feature and does not require a qualified electronic signature. There are no restrictions on the number of people who can subscribe.

After selecting the “Subscribe” button, a form will appear allowing user to subscribe to notifications about system stress events, which are sent via e-mail and SMS messages. To do so, user must provide e-mail address and phone number (for foreign numbers, please include the country code).

NOTE! The “e-mail” and “phone” fields are marked with an asterisk “*”, which means they are mandatory in order to subscribe to receive information about system stress events. If any mandatory field in a given section is left blank, it will not be possible to proceed to the next section.



2.3 Notification of information about announced system stress event

The moment a system stress event is announced, PSE sends information via SMS and e-mail to the phone number and e-mail address provided during subscription. The message includes, among other things, the date and time of the system stress event.

The e-mail with information about the announced stress event, titled "Ogłoszenie okresu przywołania na rynku mocy – DD.MM.YYYY godz. HH:00 – HH:00", is sent from purm@purm.pse.pl. An example of the e-mail content is as follows:

In place of the word “coefficient” a number with up to 10 decimal places will be entered.

The sender of the SMS message with information about the announced capacity market stress event is the number +48661000013. An example of the SMS message content is as follows:

“PSE S.A. ogłaszają okres przywołania na rynku mocy w dniu DD.MM.RRRR od GG:00 do GG:00.”, which means in translation “PSE S.A. announces system stress event on DD.MM.YYYY from HH:00 to HH:00.”.

NOTE! The sender address of the e-mail, the sender phone number of the SMS, and the content of the messages indicated in this instruction may be subject to change.

3 NOTIFICATION ABOUT TEST SYSTEM STRESS EVENT

Notifications regarding test system stress events include:

- notification of the announcement of a test system stress event for a given capacity market unit,
- notification of the completion of test system stress event verification for a given capacity market unit.

NOTE! Adding or removing phone numbers and e-mail addresses to which test system stress events notifications for a given capacity market unit are sent is only possible for users who have an account in PURM and have been assigned the role of rightholder.

PURM allows user to designate users who will receive notifications about the announcement of a test system stress event for a given capacity market unit, in accordance with point 16.8.1.3 of the Capacity Market Rules. To view the list of phone numbers and e-mail addresses to which test system stress event notifications are sent, log in to PURM and then select from the main menu: „Performance” → „Test system stress event” → „Information on Capacity Market Units”.



On the displayed list, all Capacity Market Units for which the logged-in user acts as a rightholder or has been granted permissions to browse capacity agreements or for processing of capacity agreements and settlements are shown. By default, the list presents all units with a valid certificate issued in the certification for the given delivery year.

To switch the view to a different delivery period, select the appropriate delivery year and quarter from the list. It is also possible to display only those units for which a test system stress event has been announced in the given quarter. To do this, check the box „Show only the CMU with announced test system stress event”.

After selecting this option, a form will appear allowing user to add a phone number or e-mail address to the notification list for receiving test system stress event notifications for the selected Capacity Market Unit. To do this, user must provide the name of the notified party and either a phone number (including the country code) or an e-mail address.

NOTE! The „Name of the notified party” field is marked with an asterisk „ * ”, which means it is required in order to add a notified party. The “Telephone number” and “Email address” fields are marked with a double asterisk „ ** ”, which means that at least one of these values must be entered to add a notified party. If any required field is left blank, it will not be possible to add the notified party.

If the telephone number or e-mail address is entered in an incorrect format, a message will be displayed: “Invalid telephone number” or “Invalid email address,” respectively.

NOTE! The “Telephone number” field is pre-filled with the Polish international country code “+48” by default. If user is adding a notified party with only an e-mail address, remember to remove the country code so that the “Telephone number” field remains empty.

If the phone number or e-mail address of the notified party being added is the same as one already on the list, after selecting the “Save” option, the following message will be displayed, respectively: “The defined telephone number already exists in the list for test system stress event notifications for this capacity market unit” or “The defined email address already exists in the test system stress event notification list for this capacity market unit.” To reconfigure notifications for a given phone number or e-mail address, user must first remove the previous entry from the notification list, in accordance with section 3.3 of the instruction.

To change the settings for a given notified party, uncheck the boxes „” in the „SMS notification” and „E-mail notification” columns, and then select the „Save” option.

Although it is not possible to remove a user acting as a bidder from the notification list, at this stage it is possible to disable test system stress event notifications for this user. To do this, after the message indicating that the operation cannot be performed is displayed, select “**Ok**” in the message. Notifications for the user acting as a bidder will then be completely disabled (while keeping the data on the notification list). If user select “**Cancel**” in the message, the current settings for the user acting as a bidder, for whom user attempted to remove from the notification list, will remain unchanged.

3.4 Notification of information about test system stress event

The moment a test system stress event is announced for a selected Capacity Market Unit, PSE provides this information by sending an SMS and e-mail to the phone numbers and e-mail addresses specified in the register. The message includes, among other things, the date and time of the test system stress event.

The e-mail message with information about the announced test system stress event, titled “Ogłoszenie testowego okresu przywołania na rynku mocy,” is sent from purm@purm.pse.pl. An example of e-mail content is as follows:
